## Security

If the project cannot be accessed anonymously, the `sonar.login` and `sonar.password` properties are now required to run an analysis.

## Upgrade the Motion Chart Plugin

If it's already installed, then the Motion Chart plugin must be upgraded to version 1.5.

## The `sonar.core.codeCoveragePlugin` property is deprecated

The `sonar.core.codeCoveragePlugin` property is deprecated. Even if it's still supported, it should be replaced by the `sonar.java.coveragePlugin` property on Java projects. There are currently no new properties for other languages.

Note that the upgrade automatically converts the property when it's declared in General or Project Settings.
